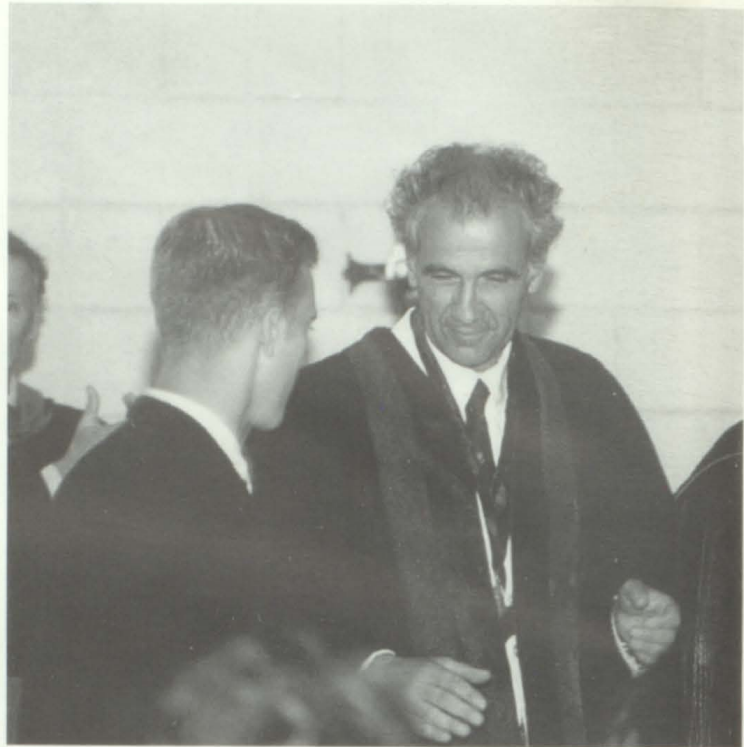
## HEADMASTER'S GREETING
