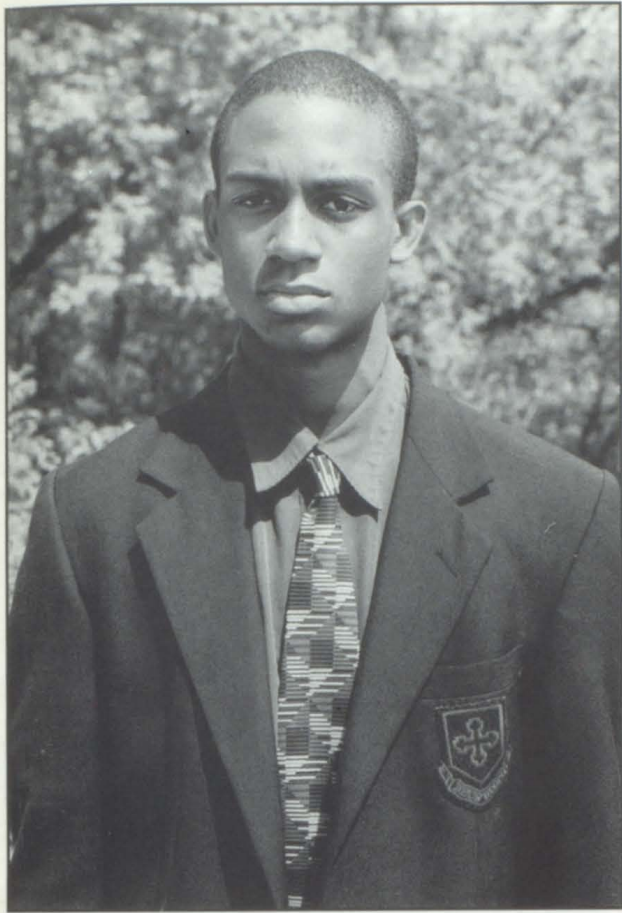
Holly- I will miss acting in front of the video camera in Dudley. Hanging out with you and getting to know you has been fun. Good luck next year.
